

Pre-migration Checklist

Introduction

This checklist provides a framework for a successful reporting system migration and is designed to capture the high-level activities required to ensure a seamless transition to the Jaspersoft commercial edition.

By maintaining the integrity of your existing reports while also taking full advantage of Jaspersoft's robust features, companies often see improved performance and scalability, leading to greater productivity and organizational efficiency.

01 Examine

Survey your current systems	☐ Inventory all existing reports, their purpose, frequency of use, and users	
	Identify all data sources feeding the reports including their locations, access methods, and any external APIs	
	Map out the data flow and any dependencies between reports, data sources, and other systems	
	Establish a performance baseline for key reports (e.g., execution time, resource utilization) for comparison after migration	
	Review current security measures and access controls	
Explore the target system	Confirm that the target system supports all required report formats, data sources, and functionalities	
	Ensure the target system can handle the current reporting volume and complexity along with the ability to scale for future growth	
	Evaluate the security features of the target system and plan for any necessary enhancements	
Best Practice — Report Consolidation		

Tell a story with your data, decide what information will provide value to your clients and automate the process when possible

02 Plan and Prepare

Create a data migration plan	Consider the scope of data to be migrated (historical data vs. current data)
	ldentify any required data transformation rules if necessary (e.g., data cleaning, format conversion)
	Plan out how you will extract the data and your migration method (e.g., bulk transfer, incremental updates)
Review access control	Replicate user roles and permissions in the target system
	Ensure data access policies are enforced in the new environment and implement appropriate authentication and authorization mechanisms
Validate the data	Develop a plan to load data into the new system and validate data integrity after migration
	Define acceptance criteria for data accuracy and completeness

03 Resource and Skill Assessment

Build a project team	Identify required roles (e.g., database administrators, report developers, testers) and clearly define their responsibilities	
	Allocate required resources (e.g., budget, hardware, software) to support the migration process	
Train users	Assess the team's skills and identify any training needs related to the target system	
	Request enablement sessions and leverage Jaspersoft's community, documentation, and support resources to assist during the transition	
Plan for contingency	Identify potential risks and develop mitigation strategies	
	Establish a rollback plan in case of unforeseen issues	
Best Practice — Train on the Job Involve experienced developers or consultants who are familiar with both tools to help with the conversion process		

04 Testing and Validation

Test plan development	Create a comprehensive test plan covering all aspects of the migrated reporting system
	☐ Include functional testing, performance testing, security testing, and user acceptance testing
Setup a test environment	Develop a dedicated test environment that mirrors the production environment and populate the test environment with representative data
	Execute the test plan and document any issues or discrepancies to implement necessary fixes or adjustments
Monitor performance	Track the stability and compare performance metrics with the established baseline
	Collect feedback and fine-tune the system as needed to optimize performance
